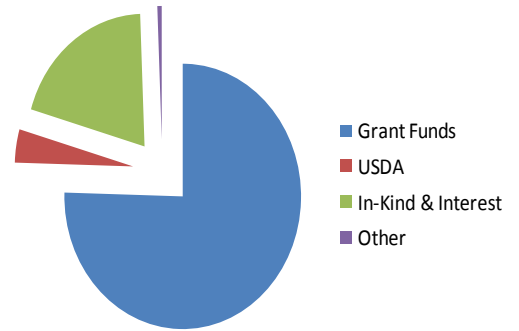

## Monitoring Review

As a result of the tri-annual federal review conducted April 2009 the Pace Head Start and Early Head Start program was found to be in full compliance. The use of technology was identified as an area of particular strength for Pace due to our use of Genesis Earth, Creative Curriculum online, and our agency intranet. A team of seven Federal Reviewers spent five days collecting data, interviewing staff, and observing operations centered around eleven service areas including: health, nutrition, safe environments, transportation, disabilities, mental health, family and community services, education and early childhood development, fiscal management, program design and management, and ERSEA (eligibility, recruitment, selection, enrollment, and attendance) which resulted in a final determination of no areas needing corrective action. This is an awesome feat considering that over 1800 regulations are in place for the programs.

## Audits

Following the 2010 Audit, Comer, Nowling & Associates issued an unqualified opinion with no significant deficiencies identified.
