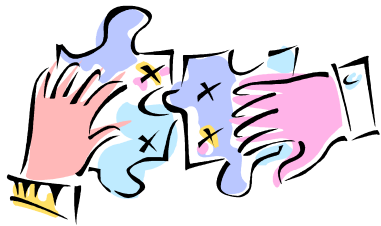


What We Do

Client Services is your initial contact point with our agency. Through **outreach, advocacy and referral** we can connect you to the services you may need through our agency or other community services.

The following are services provided through Client Services:

Project Lift— primary focuses on individuals who are working and/or going to school (older adults also may qualify). Project Lift assists individuals and families faced with unexpected emergencies when no other form of help is available. Emergency needs may include medical, dental and vision expenses; transportation issues; and housing and utility assistance. Eligibility is determined by household income up to 225% of federal poverty guidelines



We help connect you to available community resources.

At Pace Community Action Agency, we Educate, Empower & Improve through organized steps at a *personalized pace*.

Services Available

Emergency Food & Shelter— this program is funded through the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) to provide rent/mortgage and utility assistance. Guidelines are county specific.

Energy Assistance— the program is designed to help households with winter heating and summer cooling costs. Benefits are determined by household size, income (eligible at 150% of poverty), heating fuel types, at-risk persons (elderly, disabled and children age 5 and under) and geographic location.

Vincennes Food Pantry— helps meet emergency food needs of a household by providing food staples. PACE provides assistance to the Food Pantry by operating as the distribution center. Households must be located in Vincennes, Decker, Wheatland or Monroe City and have applied for or received food stamps.

In addition to these services, you may also access other PACE Programs, including Early Head Start, Head Start, Health Connection, Healthy Families, Home Rehabilitation, Weatherization and Women, Infants & Children (WIC) if applicable.

- Date of birth for each individual in household
- Proof of income for past 12 months, including- wages, TANF, Social Security, SSI, Interest, Child Support and/or Alimony, Self-employment, Cash from odd jobs.

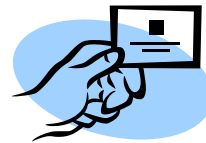
