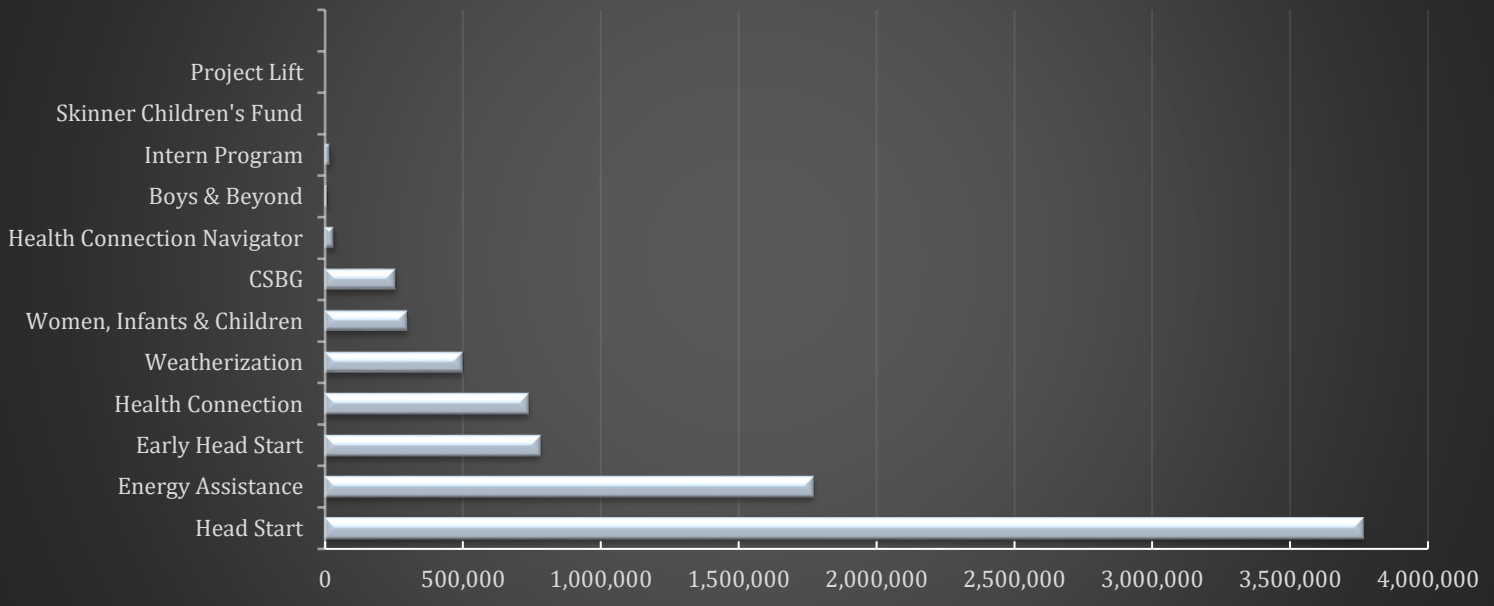


Our Mission: We provide support services to improve the community & encourage self-reliance.

**Our total 2017 budget is \$8,106,157**

In 2016, we spent over \$8 million dollars to improve the community and encourage self-reliance. A majority of these funds were for salaries. Vendors and contractors are paid for services, many of which are local in our four counties; we do not provide money directly to customers.

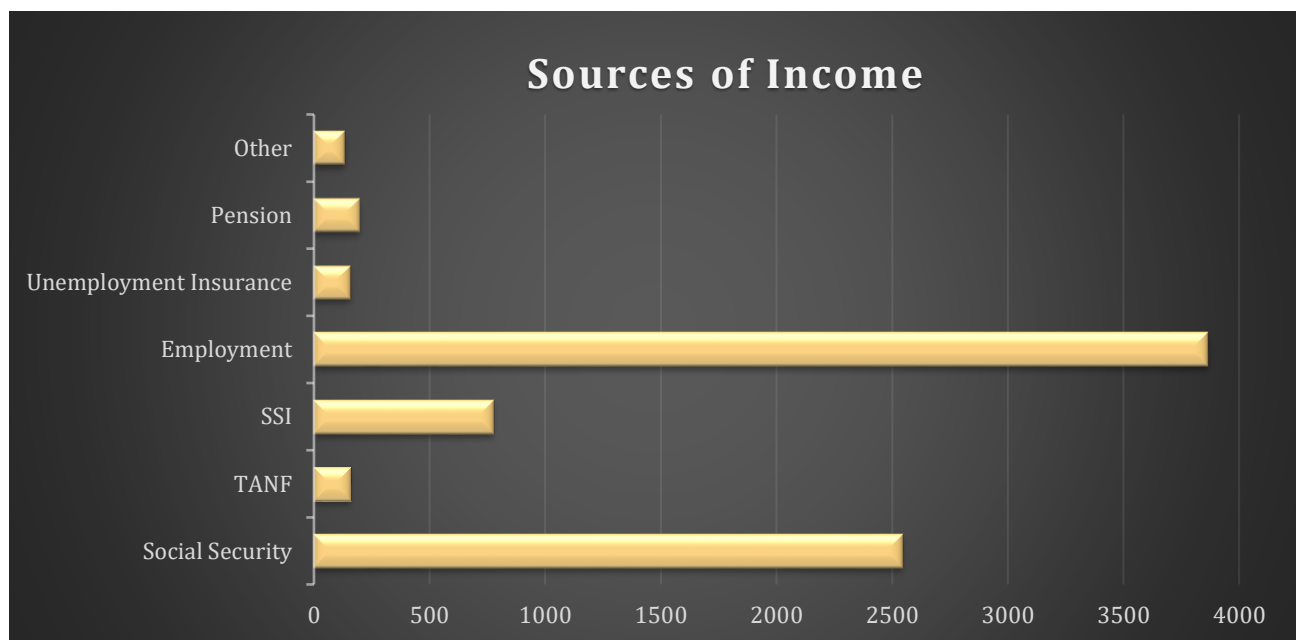
# Client Demographics

What do you think our “typical” client looks like? Some people have myths about the types of individuals we serve. Most of our clients have employment income, are small families, and are educated.



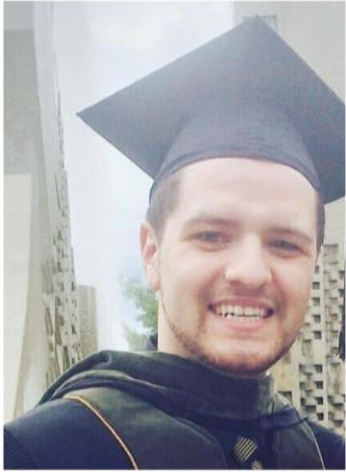
