April Magna Tile Activities

Magna Tiles can be used for several different activities, such as counting, sorting, reading, and building. An activity idea sheet is attached. Please spend time each week with your child either counting, sorting, reading, or building.

- Dominos: Lay nine square magna tile pieces down flat on the floor or a table. Place ten magna tile pieces standing up. Once the pieces are standing up push the front magna tile. The pieces will fall like Dominos. Repeat to continue playing.
- Color Sequence: Create a color sequence of magna tiles. Have your child imitate your color sequence. Your child can then create the color sequence.
- 3-D Shapes: Have your child build different 3-D shapes. They can build 3-D triangles, squares, or rectangles.
