Buckle my Shoe



One, two, buckle my shoe Three, four, shut the door Five, six, pick up sticks Seven, eight, lay them straight Nine, ten, a big fat hen



For infants:

- Sing "One, Two, Buckle my Shoe" to your infant in a soothing voice, putting emphasis on the numbers. Watch as your infant responds to different facial expressions.
- You can also show your infant the items from the song. Point to their shoes, the door, and sticks in the yard.

This activity helps with following limits and expectations (Obj. 1b), attending and engaging (Obj. 11a), and counting (Obj. 20a).



For toddlers:

- Sing "One, Two, Buckle my Shoe" with your toddler and encourage them to count along.
- During or after the song, ask your toddler to buckle their shoe, shut the door, and pick up sticks. Give them one direction at a time, and assist them with these tasks.

This activity helps with following directions (Obj. 8b), attending and engaging (Obj. 11a), and counting (Obj. 20a).
