



Activity Name: Counting and numbers are early math skills toddlers and preschoolers should be working on. There are many opportunities to count and talk about numbers every day. While you are at home you can look around your home and count objects, shapes, colors, and much, much more. If you have a writing utensil handy (pencil, chalk, crayon, marker, pen) and a piece of paper you can extend the activity by having your child write or trace the number of each object. For older children, it is good to follow up and ask them to recall how many object were counted. For example; How many times did we find something purple?
