



Activity Name: Draw an Object

Instructions: Sit with your child and look at an object to draw. Talk with them about the different shapes that you see that make up the object. (ex. A door – I see that the outside shape is a rectangle and it has four smaller rectangles and two small squares inside the door. I also see that there is a small circle inside the large square as well. See how the rectangles are aligned with each other and the squares?) As you are describing the shapes that you are seeing in the object be drawing those shapes. Encourage your child to draw the object next to you at the same time. As your child gets comfortable drawing the objects with you describing them, have them start describing the object to you as both of you draw the object.

Objective: This activity will help your child learn their shapes as well as early writing skills. Talking about what you see and what you are drawing will also help your child build language and vocabulary skills. Obj. 7b, 8a, 8b, 9a, 9b, 10a, 21a, 21b
