## ENERGY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

The Energy Assistance Program assists low-income households with the high cost of their home energy. Approved applicants receive a one-time winter heating benefit. Energy Education is provided, outlining ways to conserve energy within the home in order to lower utility costs.

In Program Year 2021 (November 2020 – May 2021), the following benefits were provided:
