Head Start & Early Head Start:

a no-cost education program for lowincome children ages birth through 5 and their families. Services provided include education, health, parent involvement activities and social services for the entire family as well as, special services to preschool children with recognized disabilities.



Options:

Center-Based– Head Start classrooms meet Monday-Thursday from 8am-3pm.

Home-Based– staff visit children & parents in their own home for 1 ½ hours weekly with group socialization 2 times a month in the classroom or on a field trip.

<u>Head Start Services</u>

Children are introduced to many educational programs and will learn new things such as number and language skills that will prepare them to enter kindergarten. A learning plan is developed for each child to fit their specific needs.


Children receive health screenings and information.
