

Learning From Home....

For Toddlers:

ABC Hunt

- Begin in your house or outside if you feel like going for a walk
- Find things that begin with the letter A such as (apple) or for outside (acorn)



- Try to find something for each letter of the alphabet if possible!
- Remember to practice the sounds of the letter as well

This activity helps your child development language skills such as 8b (follows directions) 9b (speaks clearly) 10b (uses social rules of language). This also develops your child's cognitive skills such as 11a (attends and engages) 11c (solves problems). It will also work on literacy skills such as 16a (identifies and names letters) 16b (identifying letter-sound correspondence)

Laundry Helpers!



- Dump all the socks from your laundry on the bed
- Have your child help you find the matching socks
- Discuss the colors of the socks and why they match
- After the pairs are matched count how many pairs you have found

This activity works on social skills such as following directions (8b) Speaking Clearly (9b) Engaging in conversations (10a). It also works on Cognitive skills which includes attending and engaging (11a) and solving problems (11c). Last but not least it works on counting (20a)
