



### Activity: Letter Musical Steps

Using some paper write letters, one letter on each piece. (If your child is still working on learning letters, start with the letters in their name.) Place the letters on the floor around an open area. Play some music and you and your child move around the room (not the letters). When the music stops you and your child find the letter that is closest to you and pick it up. You identify the letter you have and ask your child if they can identify the one they picked up. (for children that already know the letters ask for the letter sound, if your child already knows this ask for a word that starts with that letter) Continue the game until your child is finished. Keep the letters to repeat the game later or do other activities with.



Variation: To make the game more exciting instead of just moving around the room see if you or your child can come up with different ways to move around the room while the music is playing.

**Learning Objective:** This game will introduce your child to following rules and strengthen their listening skills as well as work on their literacy skills as well. Obj. 2a, 4, 8b, 11a, 11b, 12a, 16a, 16b
