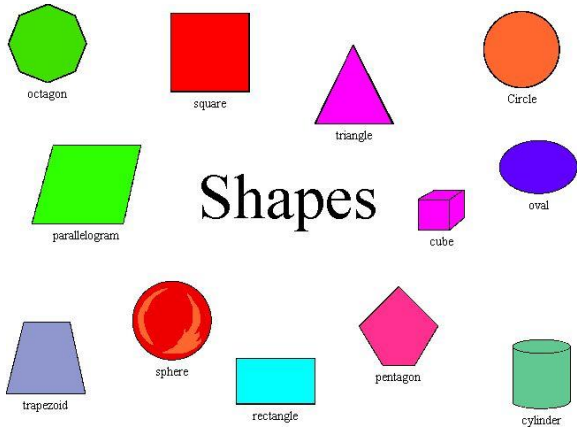


Shape Scavenger Hunt



Draw a circle, square, rectangle, triangle and oval on index cards or pieces of paper using a marker. Lay the pictures on the floor or table. The challenge is to have your child find things in the house that are those shapes. They can find as many of each shape as they want. If the item is too big for the child to bring to the shapes, simply have them show you what it is and you and your child can write that item on the card or paper with the shape. (If your child is able to help

you sound out words ask them what letters they hear as you say the word slowly, if not talk with your child about what sounds make up the word that they have told you.) This activity can be done several times as long as your child wants to play.

This lesson will work on Shape recognition as well as letter recognition and sound correlation.

Number Hunt...

- Walk around your house or outside and have your child point out any numbers they see. (look at clocks, remotes, magazines, toys, etc.)
- Can they name that number?
- Can they count to the that number?
